The procedure is: place your letter in a sealed envelope; on the sealed envelope write your return address and affix postage; write only the addressee's name on this envelope, the AFWWL will add the address and forward it. Place the sealed envelope in another envelope and mail it to the AFWWL at the above address. Information which you

may be able to include, such as service numbers, SSAN, birthdate, dates and places of assignment will be useful to the AFWWL. If your old friend has forgotten about that \$50.00 he still owes you, he will probably respond to your letter.

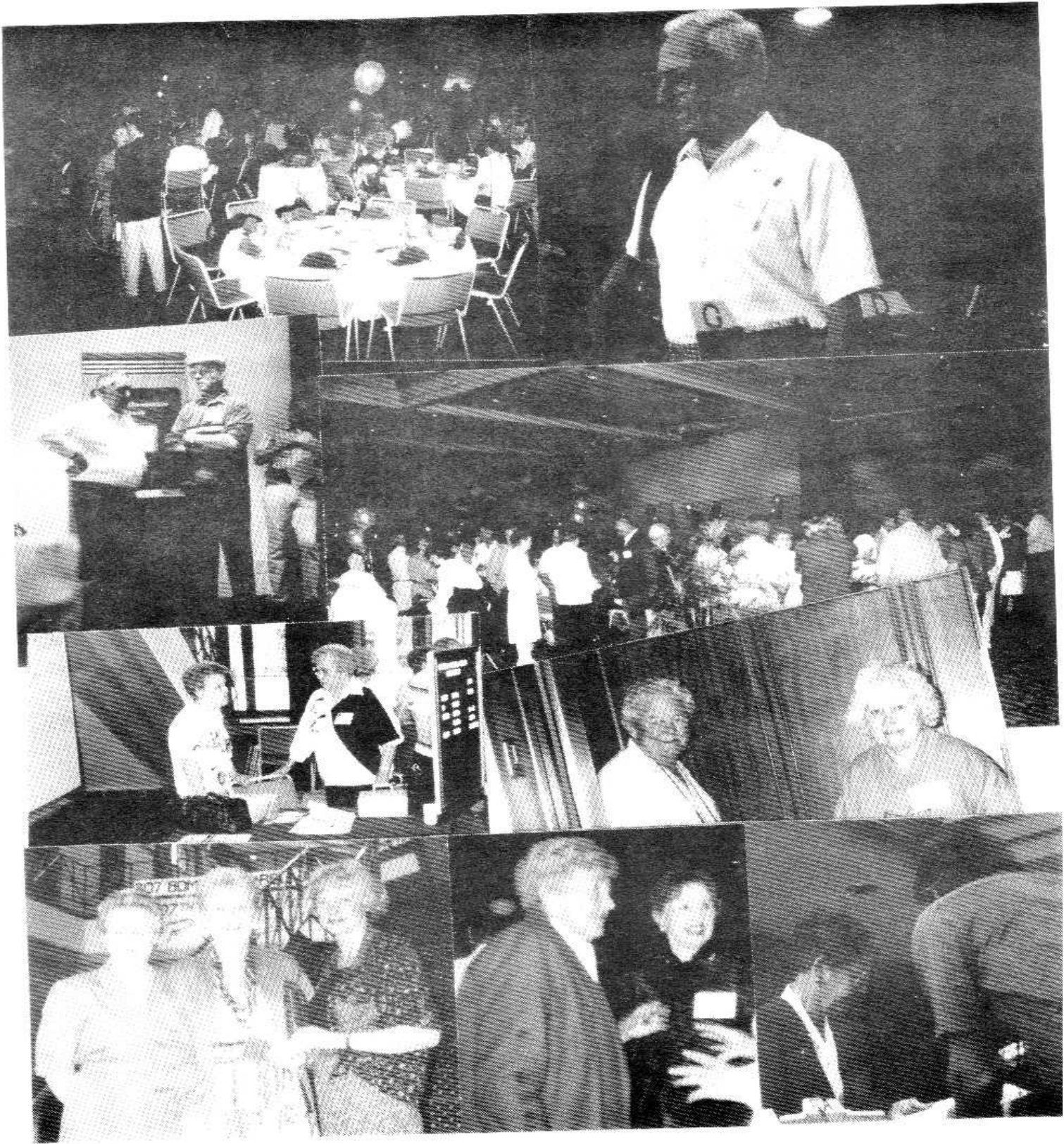

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

We do have two separate bank accounts. The general account which treasurer Ethel Dodge oversees is in Lincoln, Nebraska and the other bank account is located in the city of the next reunion; in this case, Orlando. All expenses will first be paid by the chairman, Hank Groggin, and if there is a balance left over

it will be placed in the general account for the newsletter and other expenses. The newsletter is our only way to keep in touch with you and to keep a current roster without charging dues. Therefore, it is hoped that the extra expense of sending it is justified.

It has been suggested that a silent auction be organized to provide money for the newsletter.
